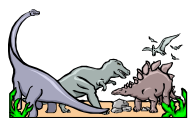

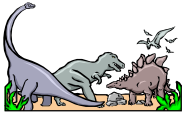

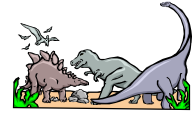

Dinosaurs at the Cottage Campus Preschool (ages 2.4 - 4 years)



Come and join us in our adventure in Paleontology! This summer we will delve into the mysteries that fossils tell us about life long ago. Learn about the many kinds of prehistoric life. We will journey through the prehistoric time using models, activities, art projects, dioramas, videos and songs. See how the dinosaurs lived together and why they became extinct. Get set to have fun with Dinosaurs!

Dinosaurs on the land: The story of a rock! Come dig up little fossils and put together the bones of dinosaurs that lived on the land. Find out who were the meat-eaters and plant-eaters.

Dinosaurs in the water: Learn about who lived in the oceans and discover who the sea beasts were. We will look at the animals that lived where the water meets the land.

Dinosaurs that traveled through the air: Gliding, diving and flying reptiles! Learn about Archaeopteryx, the first bird, Pterodactyls and other gliding dinosaurs.

The Five Senses

Come join us as we learn more about each of the five senses. During each week of this session, we will present experiences with one of our vital senses. Through activities and creative projects, children will increase their understanding and enjoyment of seeing, touching, hearing, smelling and listening. We have many hands-on materials in our repertoire that will make this subject come alive for children at this age.

Healthy Food - Healthy Body

Take a journey through the digestive system and discover how the teeth, tongue, esophagus, stomach, and intestines are involved in the process of turning food into energy. We will present the basic body systems including the skeletal, muscular and digestive. Learn about health and nutrition and how eating healthy produces a healthy body with the food pyramid. As children become involved in cooking projects and menu planning.

Geography and Our Friends Around the World

Come along as "National Geographic Explorers" to learn more about our neighbors around the world. Many cultures and people all live here in the US; we will learn more about the places we have come from and what we have brought to this land.

The Americas - We will visit some countries in Central and South America and focus on the customs, people and special places. Visits to the Amazon Rain Forest and Andes Mountains are on the itinerary.

Antarctica - We will take a look at the animals, plants and researchers that reside on this continent.

Sail to Africa - The focus will be on the Ancient Pyramids and monuments in Egypt, we will then take a trip to Nigeria where we will study the art, culture and ceremonies of the different peoples.

Travels End in Asia - India, China and the Philippines will be the main countries of interest. The largest continent will provide a wealth of knowledge for all the young travelers.

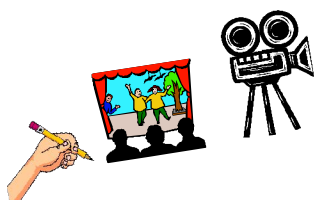
Camp Invention is the plan for a series of scientific enrichment experiences that combine in a total program to foster creativity, teamwork, inventive thinking skills, and science literacy. Come and join us in some scientific explorations.

There are three sections with overarching themes. Each week we will highlight a special series of activities that will help develop your child's "Science IQ" (Invention Quotient)

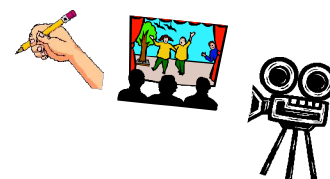
Goopy Science: Do you remember mud pies? Children will enjoy making goopy creations out of everyday ingredients while learning about the properties of matter in all sorts of forms.

Kitchen Chemistry: Science and cooking go together! Making smoothies in the kitchen will never be the same again. Children will be cooking different mixtures of recipes to create edible science experiments.

The Artistic Side of Science: Try to color a rainbow. Can color make a difference? We can mix colors using water, but wait until you see what happens when mixing colors using milk. The properties of water and air will be examined.

Back by popular demand! The summer will be filled with creative expression. We will embark on a journey learning about how to perform short scenes and small productions. Draw It: Learn about how we create the posters for a play utilizing art basics, and discovering the colors around us. A poster is created by designing then painting, coloring, and drawing.

Act It: Acting will begin by using folk tales, which will lead to group acting and learning about how rehearsals are necessary to fine tune performances which culminates with a finale for the school, families and friends each Friday.

Capture It: The third element of creative expression is to capture it through a multitude of mediums.
